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3 YEAR OLD TEACHERS REPORT

Hello and welcome everyone! We hope that you are all enjoying the start to the year and are settling in comfortably.

What a wonderful start to the year we have had with our gorgeous 3 year old group! Our welcome picnic with the children was lots of fun and it was great to see so many excited and eager faces coming through the door. The children were all very happy to see each other and were excited to once again explore the kindergarten and experience as many activities as they could.

The welcome picnic is a great way to reintroduce the children to kinder in a very relaxed and welcoming manner and helps to make their transition much smoother and less daunting.

Our first session was a huge success! With only a few tears here and there and after a few minutes the children were easily distracted by activities. As a parent it can be very hard to leave a crying child but please remember we will take good care of your children and they have normally stopped crying before you have even made it out to the car, so don't worry and you can always give us a call to check on how they are going if you are still concerned.

Over the next few weeks we will be helping the children to feel comfortable and relaxed in the kinder environment through discussing our room limits and helping them become familiar with all the new challenges that kinder can provide. We will engage in lots of small group activities to help the children become familiar with each other and will be doing some name learning games.

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4 YEAR OLD TEACHERS REPORT

A big welcome to you all, both new and returning families! It has been wonderful for us getting to know all the children and their families over the past few weeks. We have been so pleased with how both red and green groups have settled into their new kindergarten environment, and adjusted to the new routine.

Our first few short sessions with only half the group are so important for us in getting to know the children, so thank you for your patience with these. They provide us the opportunity to ensure each child feels welcomed by and secure with their new teachers and the kindergarten environment, and allow us to build strong and trusting relationships that will ensure we have a positive year together and get the best out of every child.

This first term sees us focussing on building "a sense of belonging for the children, where they feel accepted, develop attachments and trust those that care for them" (Early Years Learning Framework p20), and where they feel respected and significant. Many of our learning experiences and play opportunities will be familiar to the children, allowing them to focus on learning about themselves within the context of the kindergarten environment, building relationships with both peers and teachers, and feeling confident to explore and learn. To build a feeling of belonging, we have created our 4/5 year old apple tree- please come in and check it out! We are also focussing of supporting the children in getting to know their peers through whole group name games, and also small group art experiences.

Please ensure that your child has their sunhat in their bag each day, and that you apply sunscreen each day before they come to kindergarten. Sunscreen is available in the bag room should you forget! It's also a great idea to pack a roll on for your child so they can top up as the day goes along. Also, please pack your child a FULL SPARE CHANGE OF CLOTHES in their bag-just in case!

If, at any stage during the year, you would like to talk with us about your child's learning and development please feel free to make an appointment or chat to us when you are on duty. We are looking forward to a great year filled with fun and learning!

Even though this child might not be in your group, he can still have a life threatening reaction if exposed to them for hours after their presence in a room.
